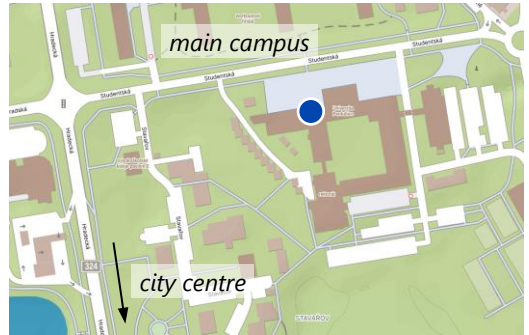
INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS

Venue

The Rolling Stock Summer School 2026 will be held at the University of Pardubice, Czechia. On Monday, Thursday, and Friday, the courses will take place in the building of the Faculty of Transport Engineering on the main campus. 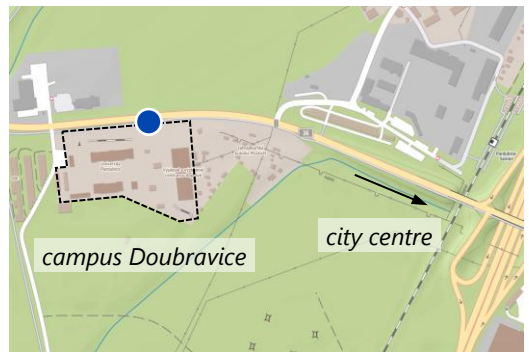

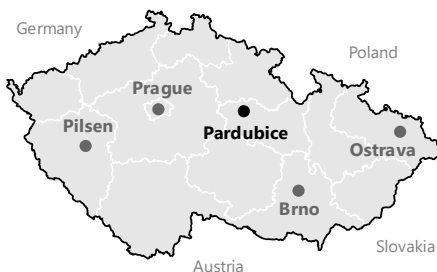


On Wednesday afternoon, we will travel together by train to the test centre of the company VUKV near Velim, about halfway between Pardubice and Prague.

Getting there

The city of Pardubice is located in East Bohemia, about 100 km east of Prague, the capital. The nearest international airport is Václav Havel Airport in Prague. There is a frequent train service between Prague and Pardubice. Pardubice also has a good railway connection with other European cities including Vienna, Budapest, or Dresden.

Public bus service is in operation in Pardubice. You can easily pay by card at the contactless payment terminals on board. To find your train or bus connection in Czechia, you can use the IDOS website (<https://idos.cz/en/>) or mobile phone app.

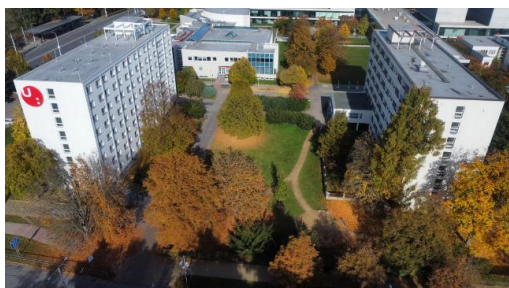

If the details you provided in the pre-registration have changed, please let us know by e-mail (rsss2026@upce.cz). Otherwise no additional information is needed to complete the registration.

The registration fee includes all lectures and seminars, course material, meals (lunch, dinner), coffee break refreshments, and transport for the technical visit on Wednesday. The registration fee does not include accommodation, breakfasts, and local transport. The fee is non-refundable, but if you are unable to attend, a substitute participant may attend in your place.

Accommodation

The expected price is 32 EUR per person per day for single occupancy, 20 EUR for a shared room. The accommodation fee will be paid upon arrival. The accommodation service does not provide breakfasts.
