Article 1 Introductory Provisions

(1) This Directive stipulates requirements for students of doctoral study programmes at the FTE to be completed prior to acceptance of their application for the state doctoral examination or the dissertation defence.

Article 2 International Cooperation

(1) An integral part of student obligations is the completion of a part of the study at an institution abroad. Minimum length of the study stay abroad is one month; the study stay can be replaced by participation in an international research project with published outcomes, or outcomes presented abroad, or a different form of direct student's participation in international cooperation.

Article 3 Research and Development

- (1) Students actively publish their academic results during the study under supervision; a minimum is two publications in an academic year with affiliation of the FTE UPa. The stress is put on valuable publication outcomes recognised within the Register of R and D information (RIV).
- (2) Before applying for the dissertation defense, student has a minimum of two publication outcomes of his/her research that are indexed in the SCOPUS database or in Web of Science.

Article 4 Participation in the department work

- (1) Students participate in the work of the affiliate department according to instructions of their supervisor and head of the department.
- (2) Students in full-time study programmes actively participate in educational activities of the relevant department (up to 6 hours a week) and events (conferences, seminars, etc.) organised by the department/faculty.

Article 5 Final Provisions

The Directive replaces the FTE Directive N. 35/2017.
