Article 1 Introductory Provisions

(1) This Directive stipulates requirements for students of doctoral study programmes at the FTE to be completed prior to acceptance of their application for the state doctoral examination or the dissertation defence.

Article 2 International Cooperation

(1) An integral part of student obligations is the completion of a part of the study at an institution abroad. Minimum length of the study stay abroad is one month; the study stay can be replaced by participation in an international research project with published outcomes, or outcomes presented abroad, or a different form of direct student's participation in international cooperation.

Article 3

Research and Development

(1) During the study, the student must publish the results of his work on the basis of an individual study plan (affiliated with the Faculty of Transport Engineering, University of Pardubice)

(2) By the date of submission of the application for the defense of the dissertation, the student must have at least two publications of his / her scientific work related to the topic of the dissertation in professional journals, which are indexed in the SCOPUS database or Web of Science

(3) The student will actively present his / her current results at least once a year at the FTE Doctoral Colloquium.

(1) Students participate in the work of the affiliate department according to instructions of their supervisor and head of the department.

(2) Students in full-time study programmes actively participate in educational activities of the relevant department (up to 6 hours a week) and events (conferences, seminars, etc.) organised by the department/faculty.

Article 5 Final Provisions

(1) The Directive replaces the FTE Directive N. 15/2019.

(2) The Directive shall enter into force on 1 September 2022.
